OPENING THE WINDOWS OF HEAVEN FOR DEFEATING SATAN, Part 5

(Continued from last week) Satan, who (as has been shown) had to give account of his actions before God (Job 1:6,7; 2:1,2), apparently had been eyeing Job--God, as this writer's dad would say, "not for information but contemplation," asked, "Hast thou considered my servant Job, ..."? (Job 1:8; 2:3). Satan affirmed that he had, and that if God removed His blessings from Job (Job 1:10), then Job would remove his reverence from God (Job 1:9,11). God, because He is fair to all--even Satan, had to allow Satan to "have his day in court" and try to prove his case, so Satan murdered (remember John 8:44) Job's children and destroyed Job's livelihood (Job 1:12-19). Job mourned, but did not stop reverencing God (Job 1:20-22). Subsequently Satan was given a bit more allowance; he could tough Job himself, but could not kill him [not that murdering Job would have helped Satan] (Job 2:4-8). Satan held no punches; in fact, one is encouraged to see the extent of Satan's attack on Job in the 2014 Spiritual Sword lecture on the "Portrait of Job." Likely no man, save the Lord, has hurt the way that Job was forced to, but he still did not stop reverencing God (Job 2:9,10).

One might view Satan's terrible persecution of Job as a victory of sorts--it surely hurt God to His heart, but Satan did not achieve his purpose (Job 1:22; 2:10); in fact, Satan would not receive ANY mention any where in the final forty chapters of the book; moreover, God was magnified, for Job said, "I know that thou canst do every *thing*, and *that* no thought can be withholden from thee. Who *is* he that hideth counsel without knowledge? therefore have I uttered that I understood not; things too wonderful for me, which I knew not" (Job 42:2,3).

SATAN'S TEMPTATION OF JESUS

The fourth scene in the conflict also took place on earth, in the wilderness. Satan had established his evil intent and cruel character in the conflicts with Adam and Eve and Job, but he had not succeeded in taking the fight truly to God [indeed, he could not since he is not God]; accordingly, he thought that he would take a shot of God Himself in the person of the incarnate "second person of the Godhead," Jesus the Christ [note that even being incarnate, Jesus was still God and not Satan's equal in a Divine sense]. On this occasion, Jesus was spiritually, from a human standpoint, at His strongest having just been baptized, not for the remission of sin (Acts 2:38) but "to fulfil all righteousness" (Mat. 3:15); physically, he was at His weakest, being in the wilderness and famished (Mat. 4:1,2). One might easily overlook the readiness of the Lord, though, for Jesus was "led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil" (Mat. 4:1).

Satan offered three temptations: first, "If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread" (Mat. 4:3); second, "Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in *their* hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone" (Mat. 4:5,6); and, third, "Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me" (Mat. 4:8,9). *(To be continued next week)*
